Description of Activity and Station Participation:

WILI AM & FM Internship Program, under the supervision of WILI VP/Marketing Manager Colin Rice, recruited students from Eastern CT State University. This program is for college credit only or college experience and is approved by the Connecticut Department of Labor. One Intern was hosted during the Spring of 2025 and two more interns worked at the station during the Summer and Fall of 2025. Each intern invested an average of 12 hours per week. Each intern worked in radio production, voice tracking, music scheduling, remote broadcast and promotions. The interns earned college credits in return. At the end of the each internship, each intern received a written evaluation from radio station supervisors, which then were sent to the student's respective department head.
