Bryan Rust scored in a second-consecutive game on Saturday night against Boston to set a new career high with 28 goals on the season.

Michael Bunting recorded a goal and assist on Saturday night against Boston and has nine points [3G-6A] over his last six games.

- Bunting has proved to be a great acquisition for Pittsburgh as he has tallied six goals, 10 assists and 16 points in 19 games since his trade from Carolina on March 7.
- Since the trade, Bunting's 10 assists rank second on Pittsburgh, while his 16 points are the fourth most:
