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III. RECRUITMENT INITIATIVES

	Type of Recruitment Initiative (Menu Selection)	Brief Description of Activity
1	Job Fairs / Recruitment Opportunities	WEJZ/WGNE-FM participates in area job fairs for recruitment. Station personnel attended the following Job Fairs seeking applicants and providing outreach activities. Representing both WEJZ & WGNE, Matt Basford and Amadeus visited the University of North Florida on 8/19/25 from 10AM to 1PM to speak to, and Q&A with, UNF's Communication Students Multimedia Club.
2	Job Listings on Radio Station Websites	WEJZ/WGNE-FM job openings are offered on our radio station websites. These offerings list the various career opportunities and how to apply for each position. www.WEJZ.com www.999GatorCountry.com
3	On-Air Advertisements of Job Openings	WEJZ/WGNE-FM advertises its job openings over a variety of dayparts on both stations to reach different listeners. WEJZ/WGNE-FM also runs on air schedules of spots (ten thirty second commercials per week) Monday through Sunday, Midnight to Midnight, inviting any organization wishing to receive notification of open positions or any

		entity wishing to be added to our recruitment list to contact us. The updated list is then used for any new job vacancy within the radio stations. Both of these types of announcements remind all listeners of the variety of job opportunities at broadcast stations such as WEJZ/WGNE-FM, even if a particular listener is not interested in the specific job opening or is not part of a group desiring notifications of openings.
4	Job Shadowing	WEJZ/WGNE-FM offers job shadowing opportunities for area students and interns. This helps to introduce people to the various departments used within broadcasting.
4	Internship Program	WEJZ/WGNE-FM offers Internships during college semesters to students who are typically juniors or seniors so that they may receive college credit as well as experience for their internships. Colleges and Universities are notified of this available resource and directed to our website for more information. WEJZ/WGNE-FM had no students apply during this reporting period.
5	Focus on Excellence Program	WGNE-FM and WEJZ perform a months-long program every year titled "Focus on Excellence". All area High School Students within the market were encouraged to participate in this program. Students who received all A's and B's on their issued report cards were qualified to win a new car through the event each year, with additional entries for those who also had perfect attendance. After the school year was completed, the radio stations pull 50 random names for the program entries. These students, along with their parents, station personnel and others meet at a local establishment for the event. Throughout the school year, staff would visit several local schools in the area to engage with students. This consisted of promoting the details of

		this program and performing outreach questions and answer sessions with the students. These sessions are used to further our outreach potential and increase awareness of the different departments and staff opportunities within the broadcasting industry. While at the final event of this program, station General Manager Bill Berry talked to several students in groups and one-on-one personal conversations about broadcasting careers. Additionally, several sponsors utilized this event in an attempt to share information about their companies for recruitment potential within their industries in a job fair capacity sponsored by the stations. These outreach and recruitment efforts during this event had the added benefit of a job fair style of recruitment event sponsored directly by the stations. 6	Area Sporting Events	WGNE/WEJZ attends station days/nights at local NFL football and minor league baseball games, as well as outdoor movie nights. Rotating on-air personnel and members of the Promotions Department attend and interact with spectators. Radio station signage solicits job inquiries, and staff on site answers questions about current openings and recruitment efforts. Such interactions show enjoyable duties of broadcasting jobs and thus place such jobs in a positive light. The stations attends all Jacksonville Jaguars home games in order to display signage and perform recruitment activities during this time period.
