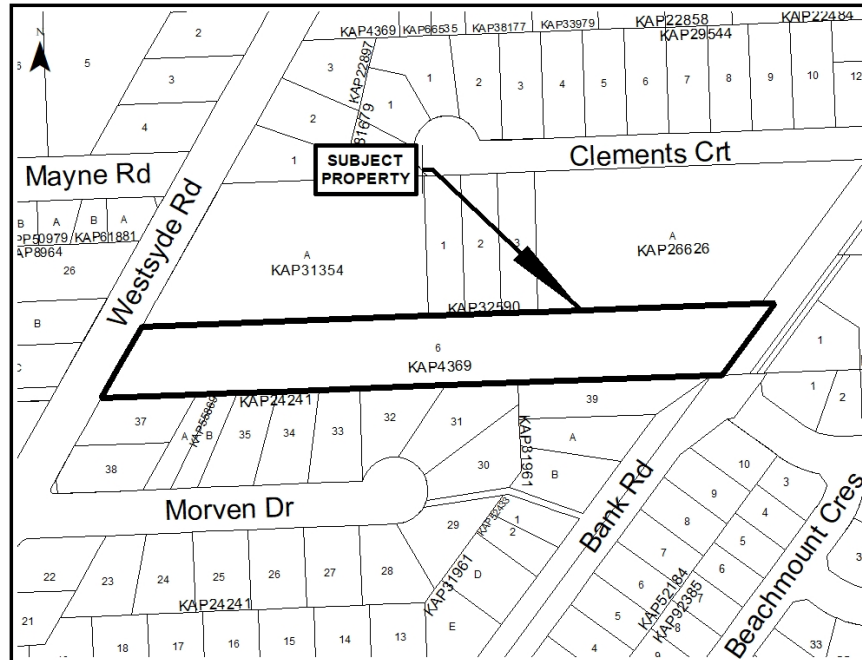
**When?** Tuesday, May 14, 2024, 9:30 am, at the Regular Council Meeting
