Why?

Kamloops City Council will consider adopting Council Procedure Amendment Bylaw No. 59-3, 2025.

Purpose

Bylaw No. 59-3 for adoption is available for viewing on the City's website at this <u>link</u>.

On January 14, 2025, Council directed staff to present the Committee of the Whole with three Public Inquiries options. On March 11, 2025, the Committee reviewed the options presented and recommended that staff prepare an amendment to Council Procedure Bylaw No. 59 to replace the Public Inquiries section with a Public Input section, under defined parameters, for Council's consideration. Proposed amendments to Council Procedure Bylaw No. 59 include the following:

- replacing all references to Public Inquiries with Public Input
- replacing the Public Inquiries provision with the new parameters for Public Input Participation
