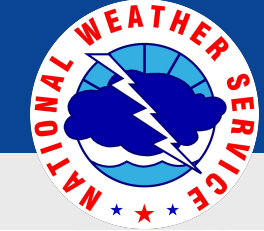
Multiple Rounds of Severe Weather Beginning Thursday & Continuing through the Weekend

## Key Messages

- **Multiple rounds** of showers and thunderstorms starting Thursday and persisting throughout the weekend.
- **Severe weather** is possible, particularly in the afternoons and evenings of Friday, Saturday, and potentially Sunday.
- **All** severe weather hazards will be possible.
- **Flooding concerns** will be present due to the possibility of recurrent thunderstorms.

## Key Points

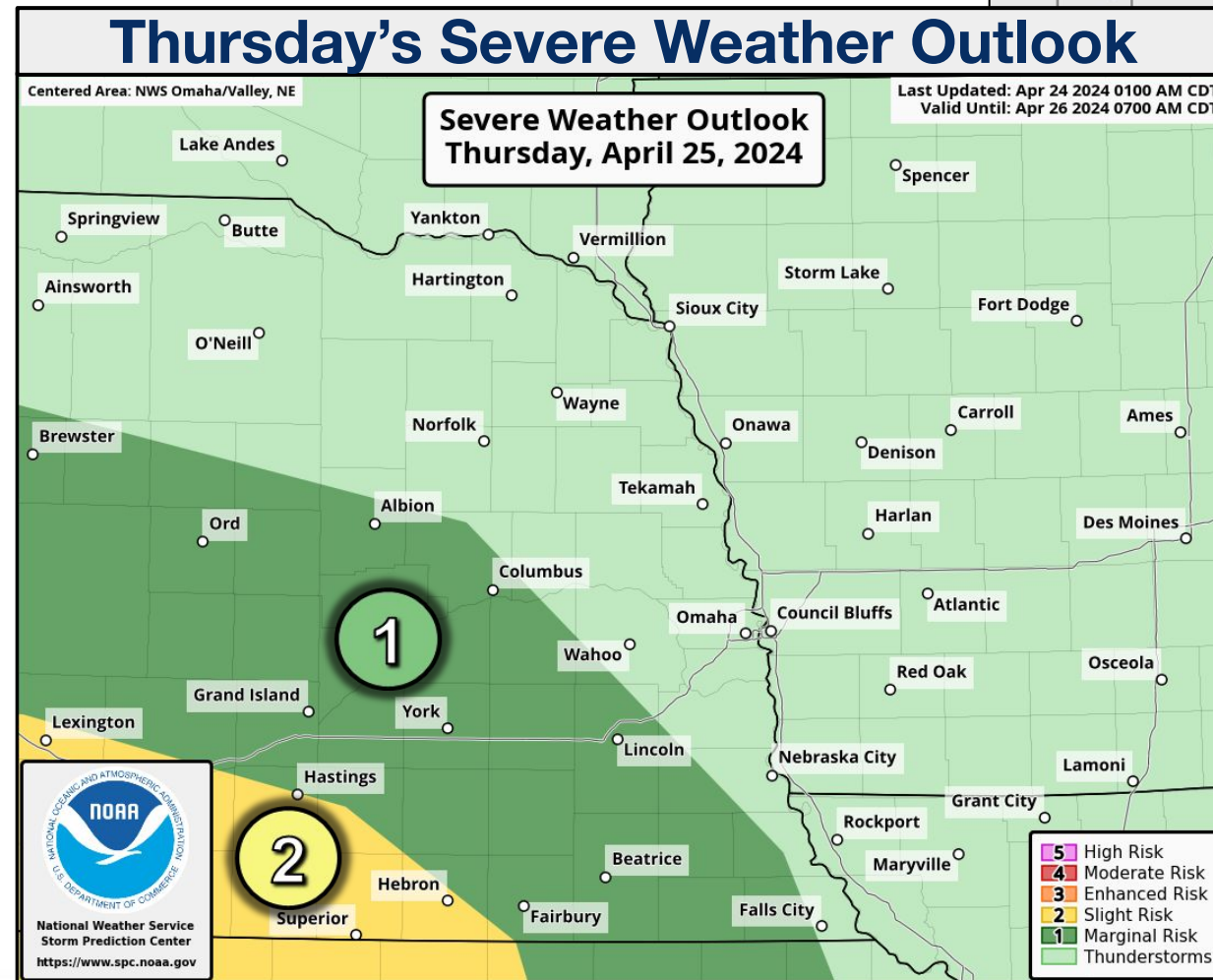
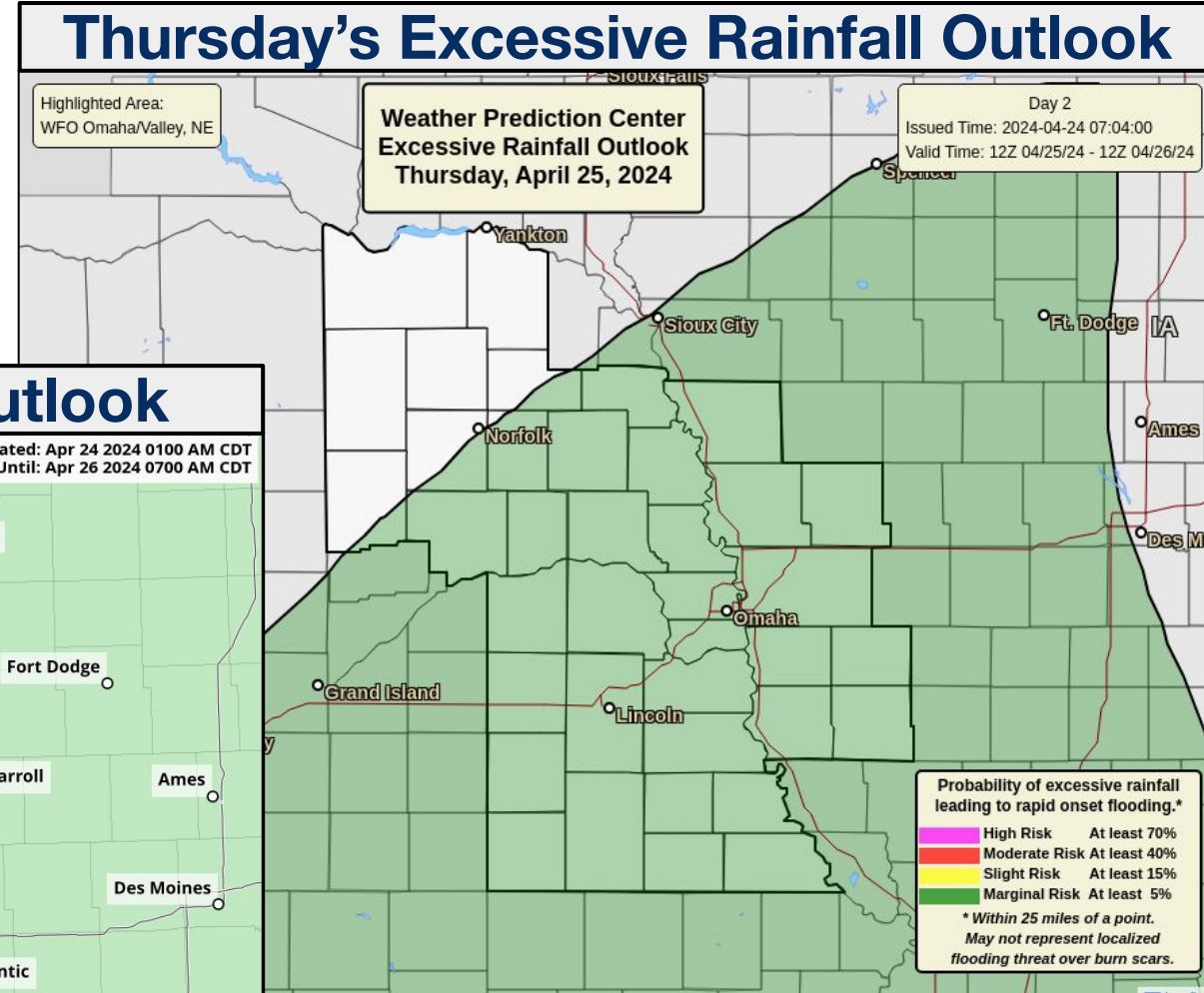
→ Thunderstorms will become widespread Thursday night with localized flooding possible across much of the area. The greatest severe threat will exist over southeast Nebraska.

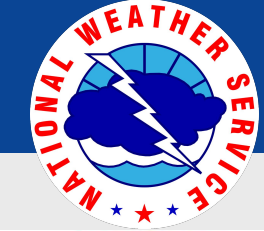

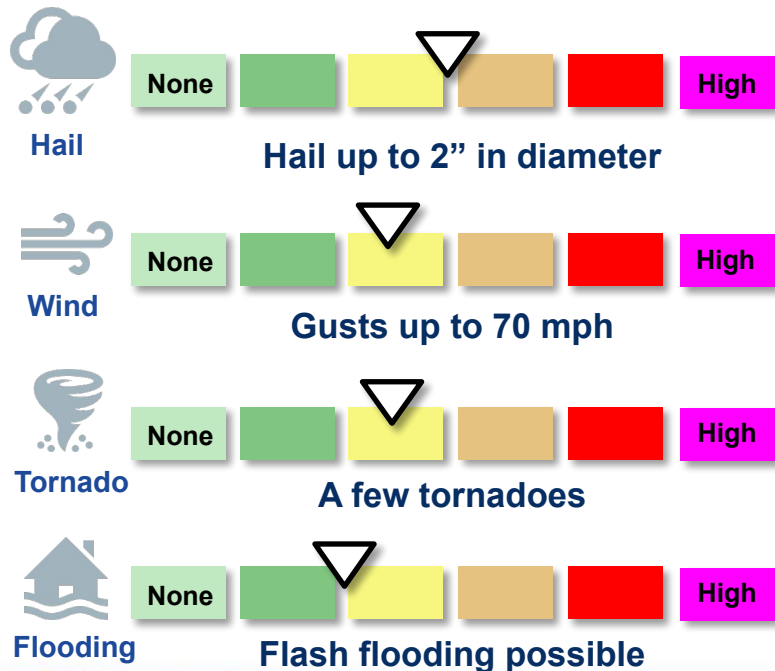
## Key Points

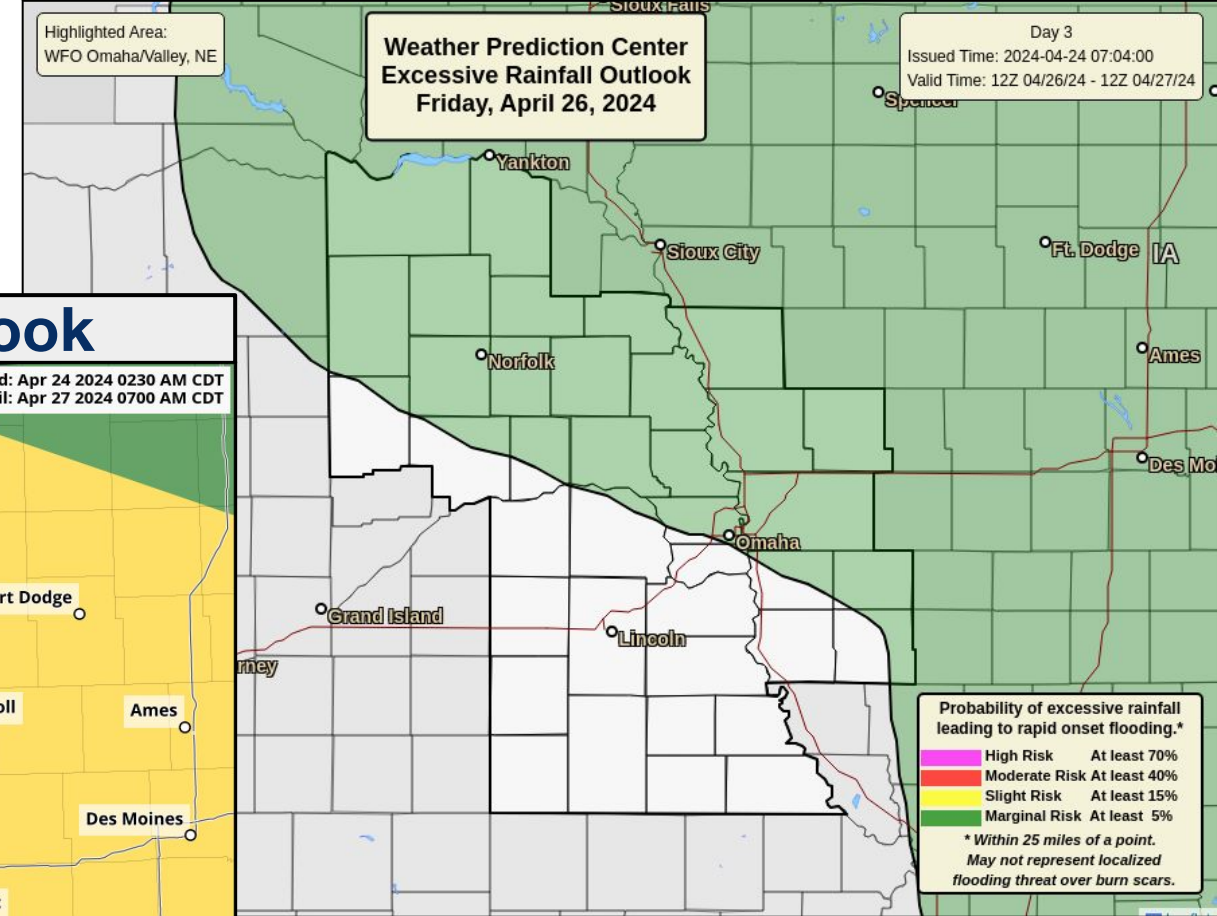

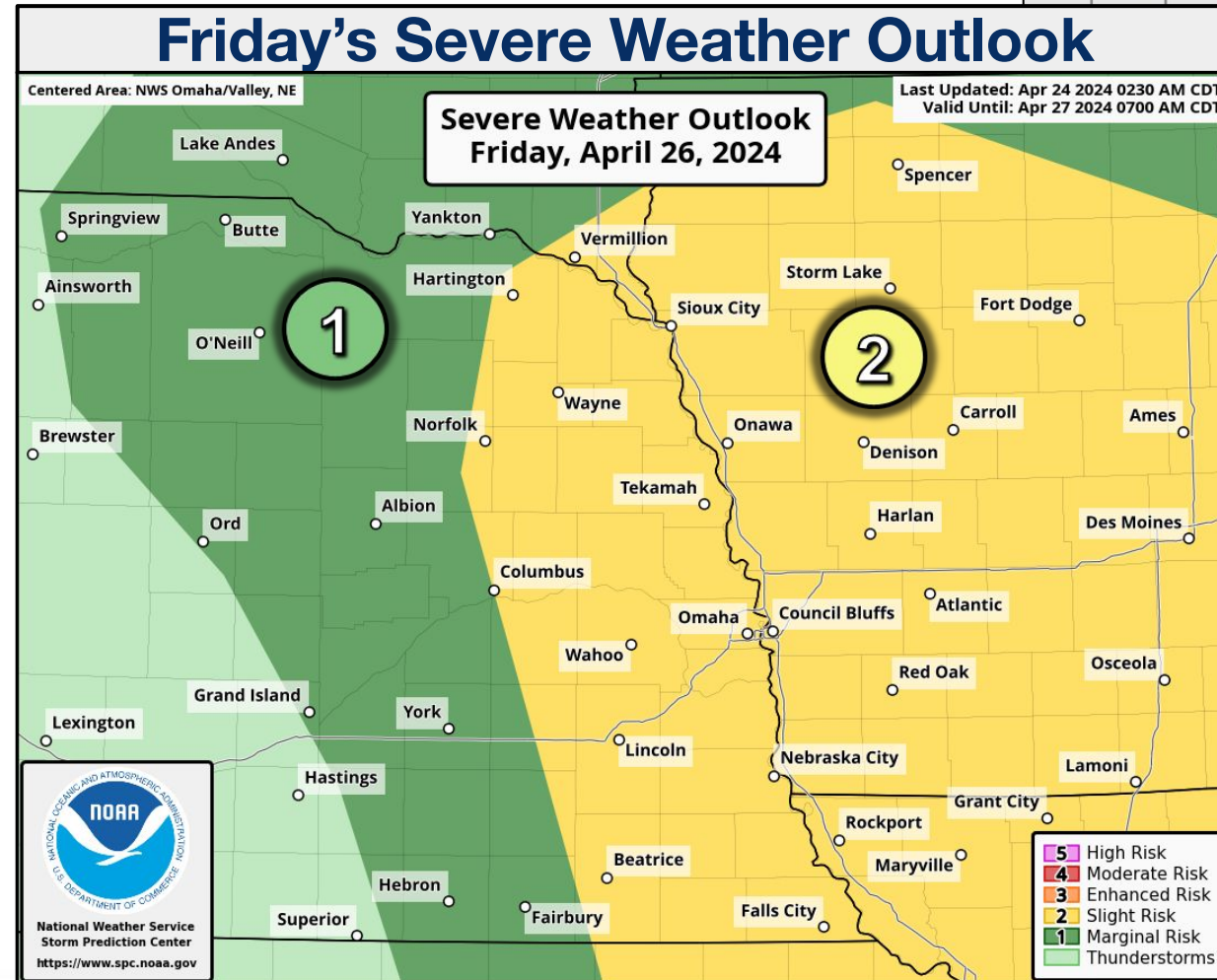

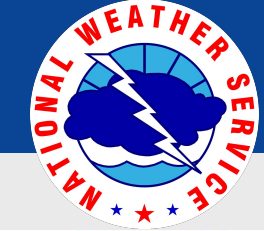


## Friday's Excessive Rainfall Outlook

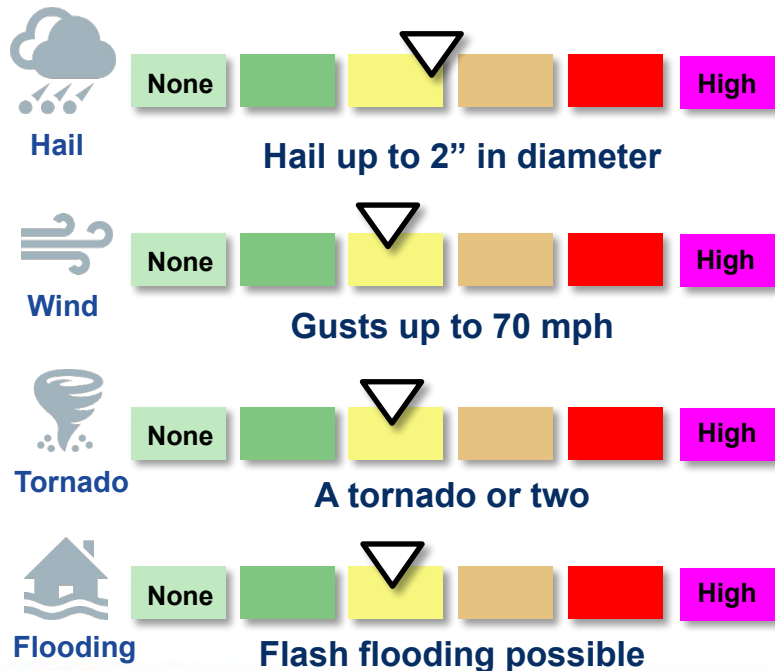
## Key Points

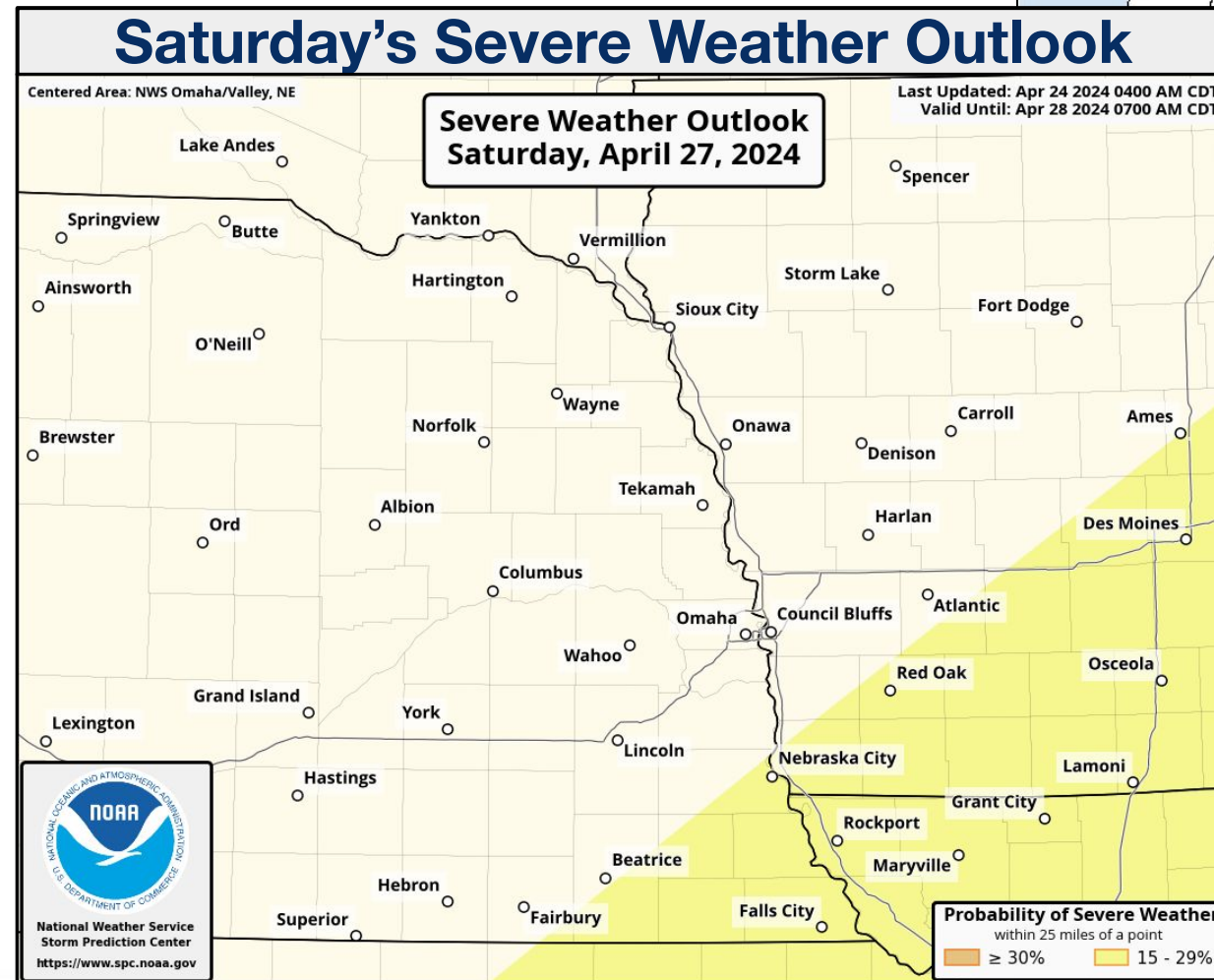
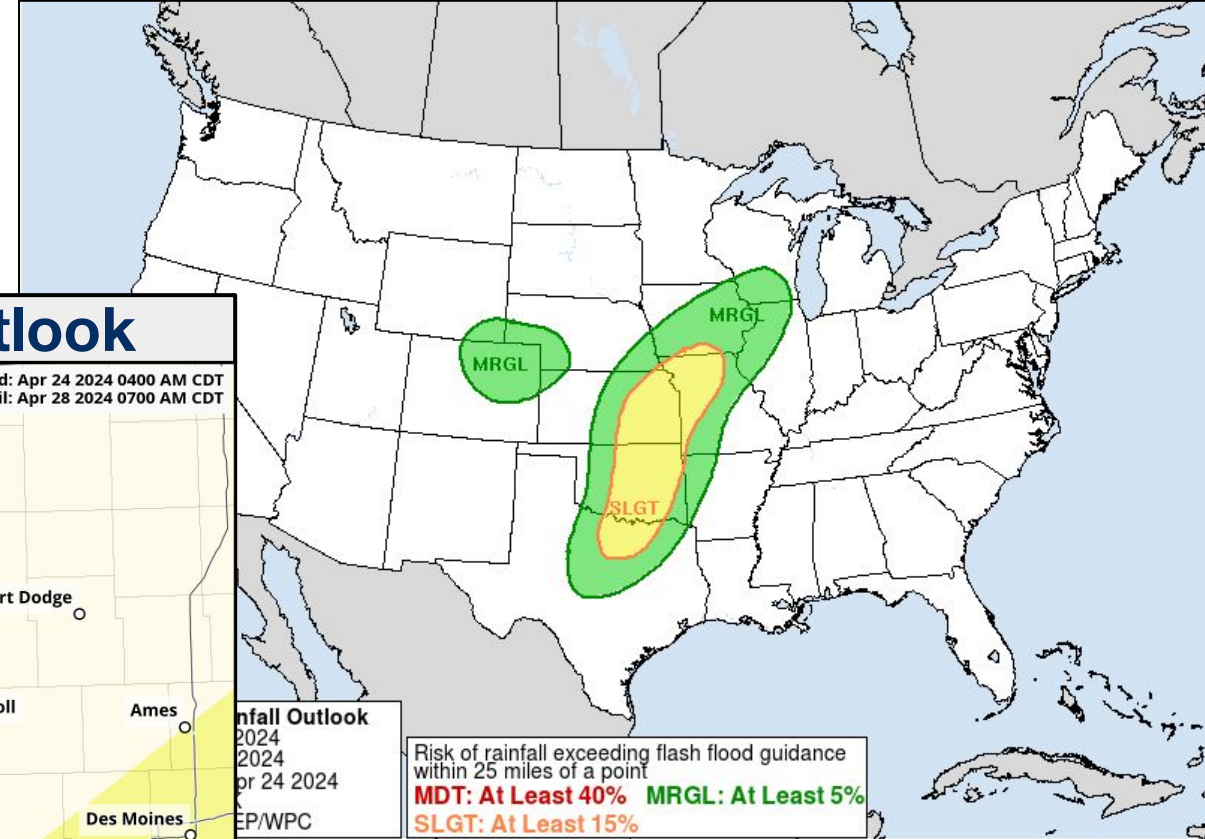
