
Multiple Rounds of Severe Weather Beginning Thursday & Continuing through the Weekend

Key Messages

- → Multiple rounds of showers and thunderstorms starting Thursday and persisting throughout the weekend.
- → Severe weather is possible, particularly in the afternoons and evenings of Friday, Saturday, and potentially Sunday.
- → All severe weather hazards will be possible.
- → Flooding concerns will be present due to the possibility of recurrent thunderstorms.


Key Points


→ Thunderstorms will become widespread Thursday night with localized flooding possible across much of the area. The greatest severe threat will exist over southeast Nebraska.

Severe Weather Potential - Friday


Key Points



Severe Weather Potential - Saturday


Key Points




