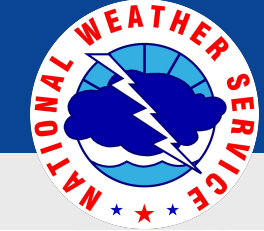
Multiple Rounds of Severe Weather Beginning Tonight & Continuing through the Weekend

Key Messages

- **Multiple rounds** of showers and thunderstorms starting tonight and persisting throughout the weekend.
- **Severe weather** is likely (>80% chance), particularly in the afternoons and evenings of Friday, Saturday, and potentially Sunday.
- **All** severe weather hazards will be possible.
- **Flooding concerns** will be present due to the possibility of recurrent thunderstorms.

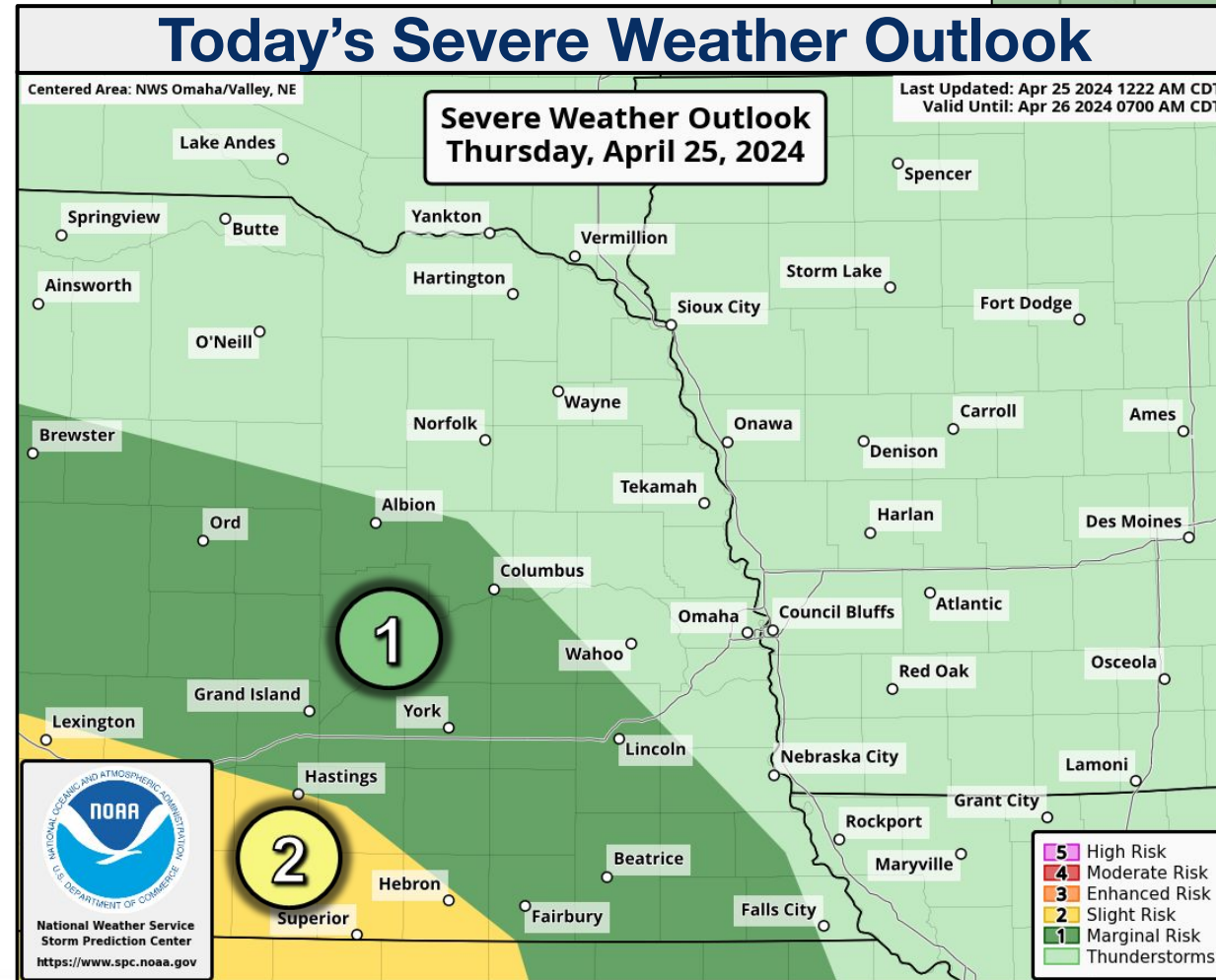
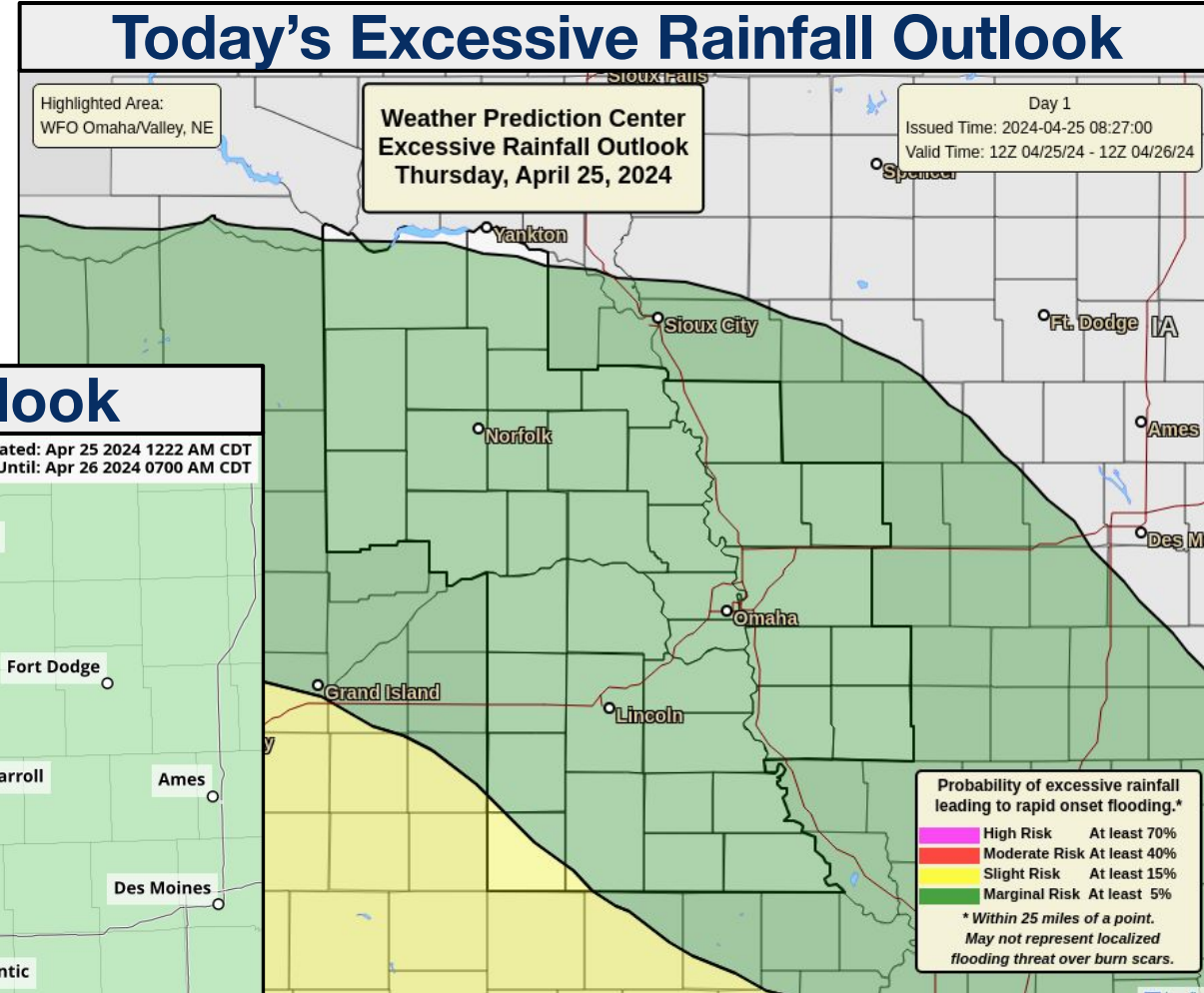
→ Wind gusts of 40-50 mph are possible with storms moving through southeast NE this morning. Thunderstorms will become widespread tonight with some severe weather and/or flooding possible (<30% chance).

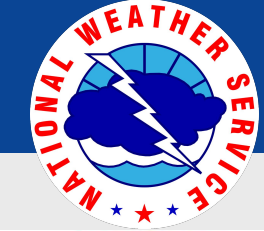

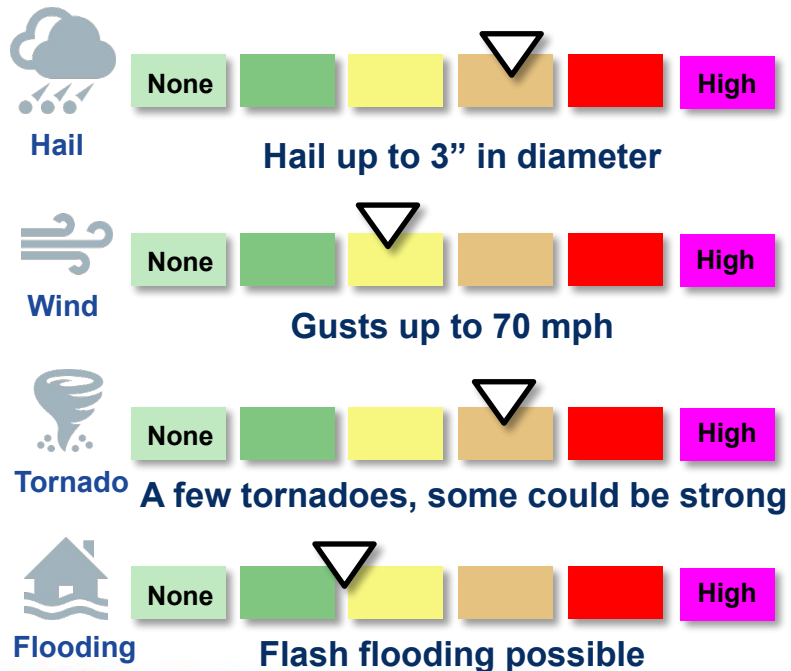
Key Points

→ A second round of thunderstorms will develop Friday afternoon and continue into Friday night. Severe weather is likely (>80% chance), including the potential for hail up to 3" in diameter, strong tornadoes, and wind gusts of 70 mph.

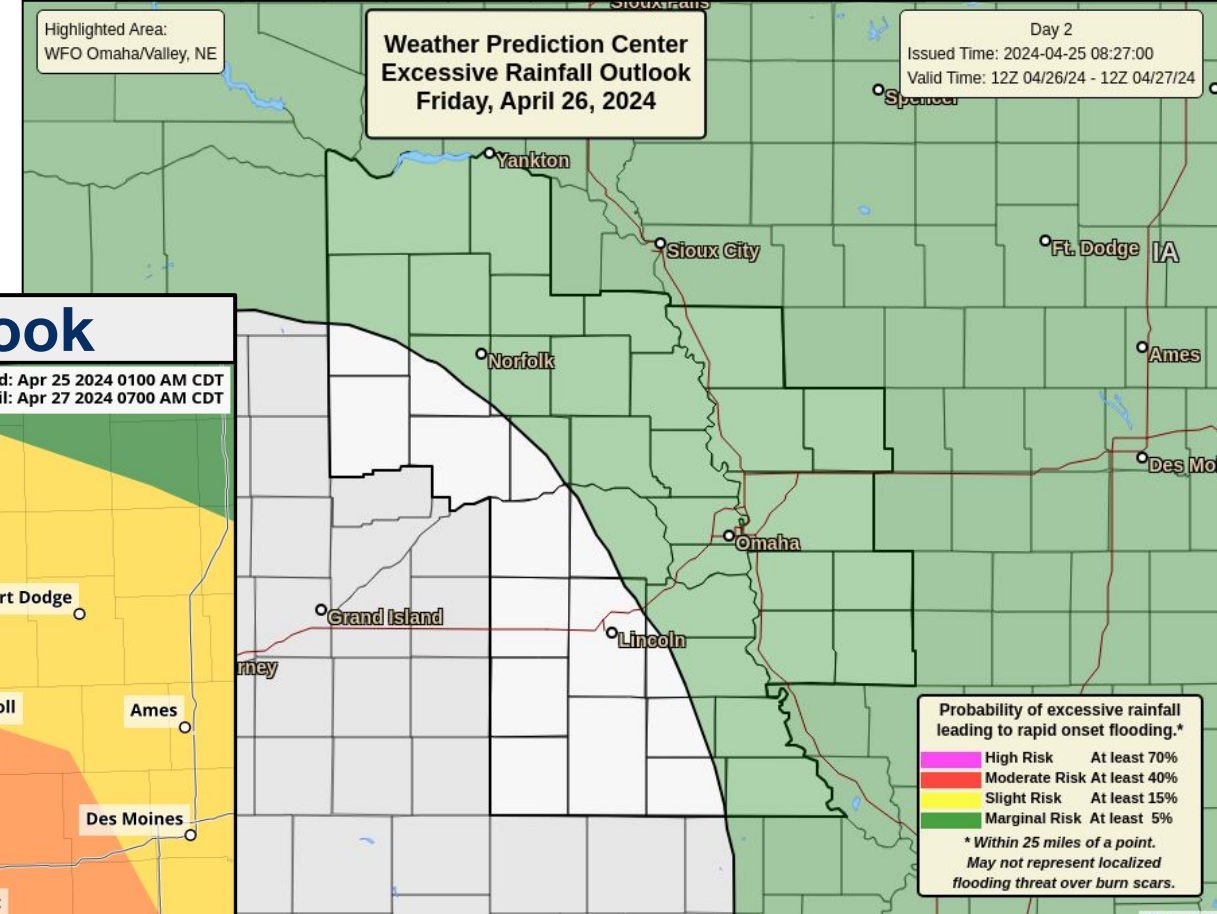

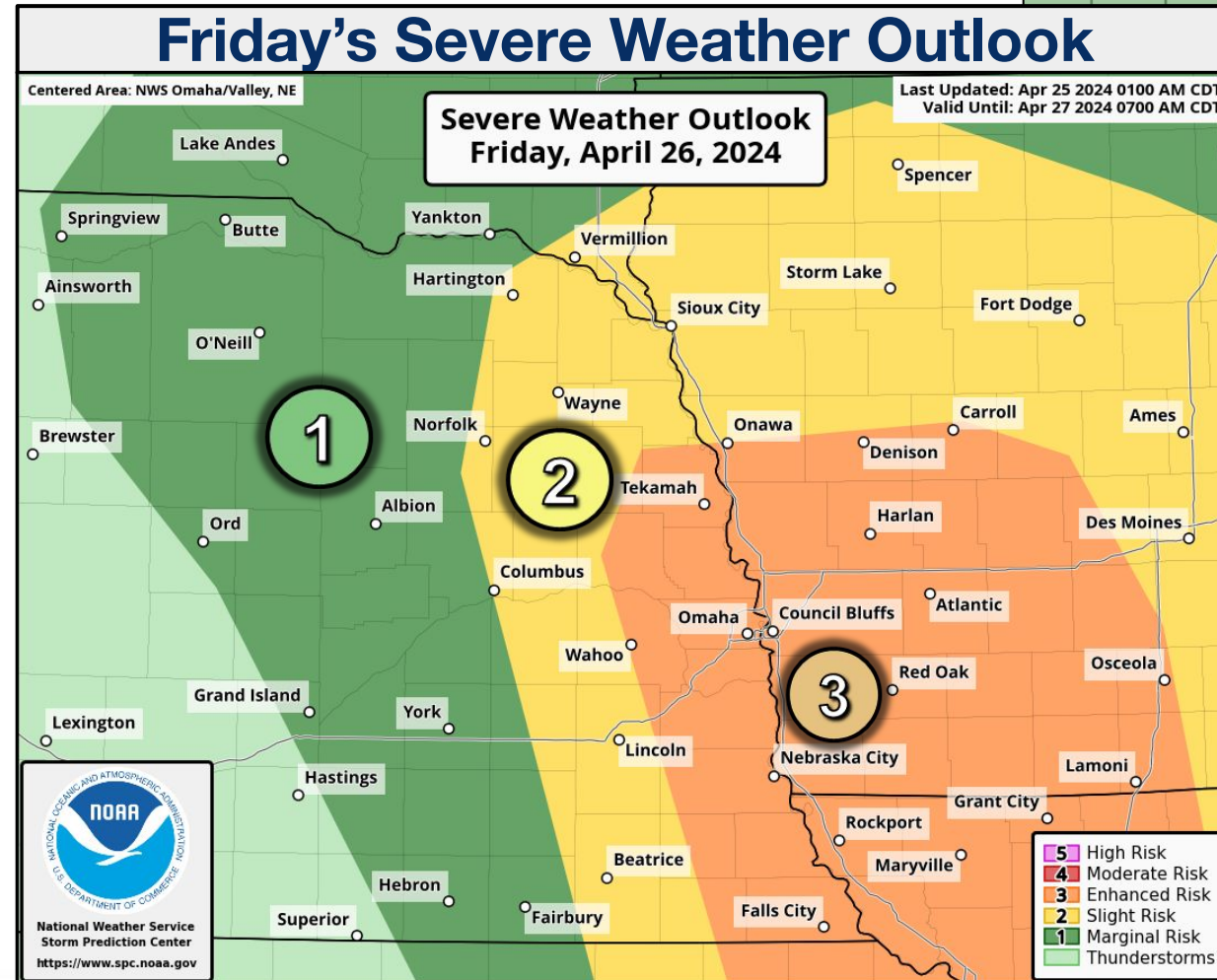

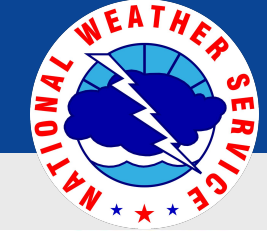


Friday's Excessive Rainfall Outlook

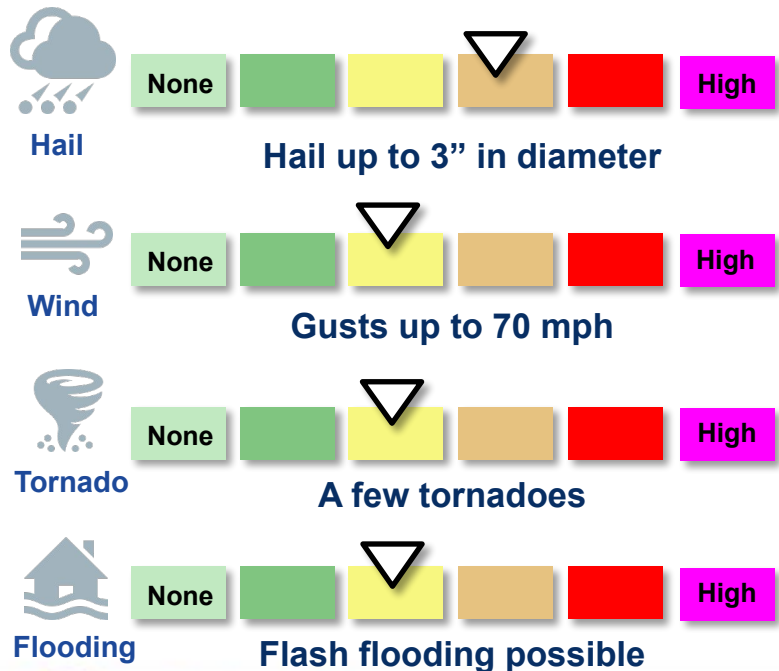
Key Points

→ A third round of thunderstorms will develop Saturday afternoon or evening and continue into Saturday night. Severe weather is again likely (>70% chance), including the potential for hail up to 3" in diameter, a few tornadoes, and wind gusts of 70 mph.

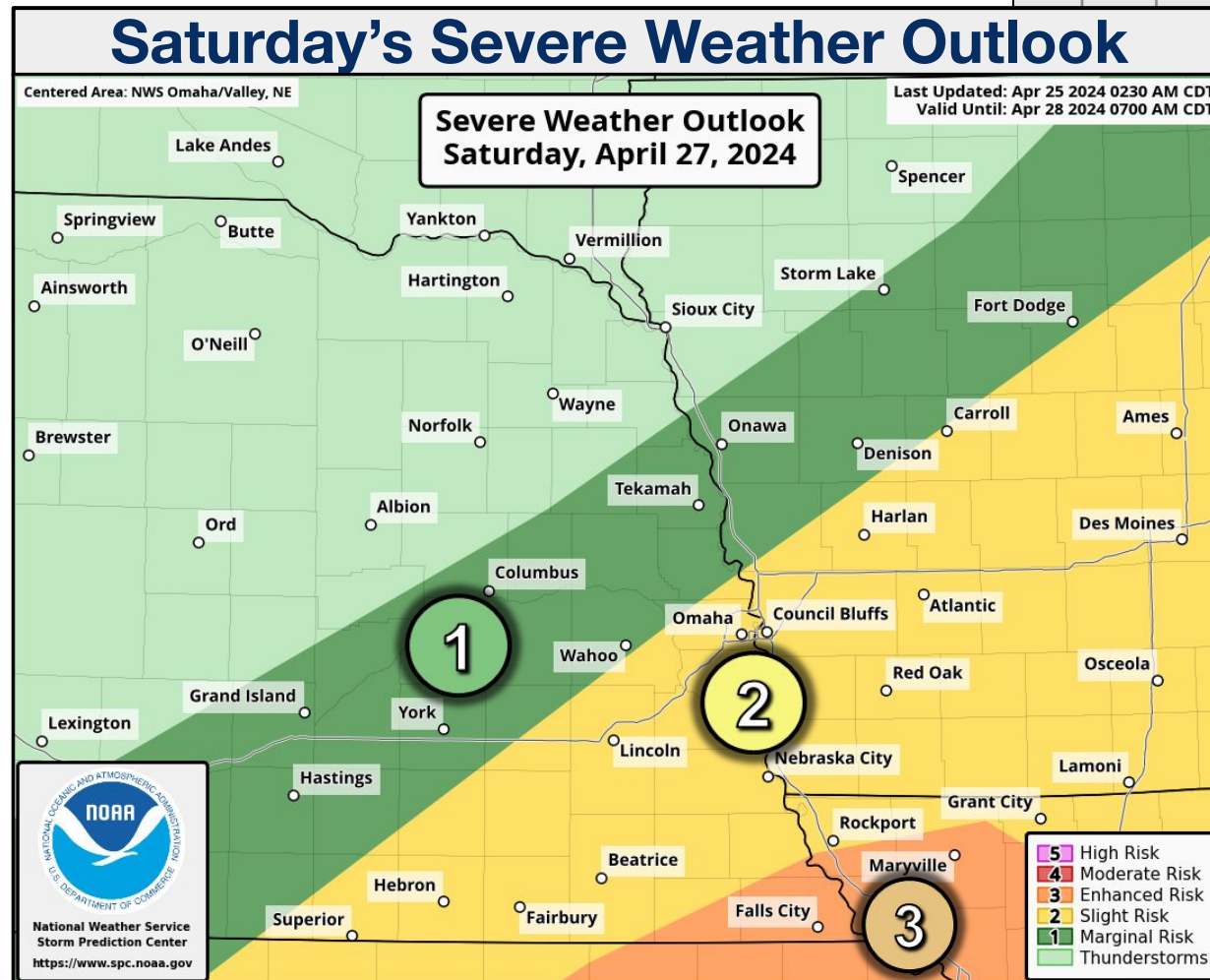
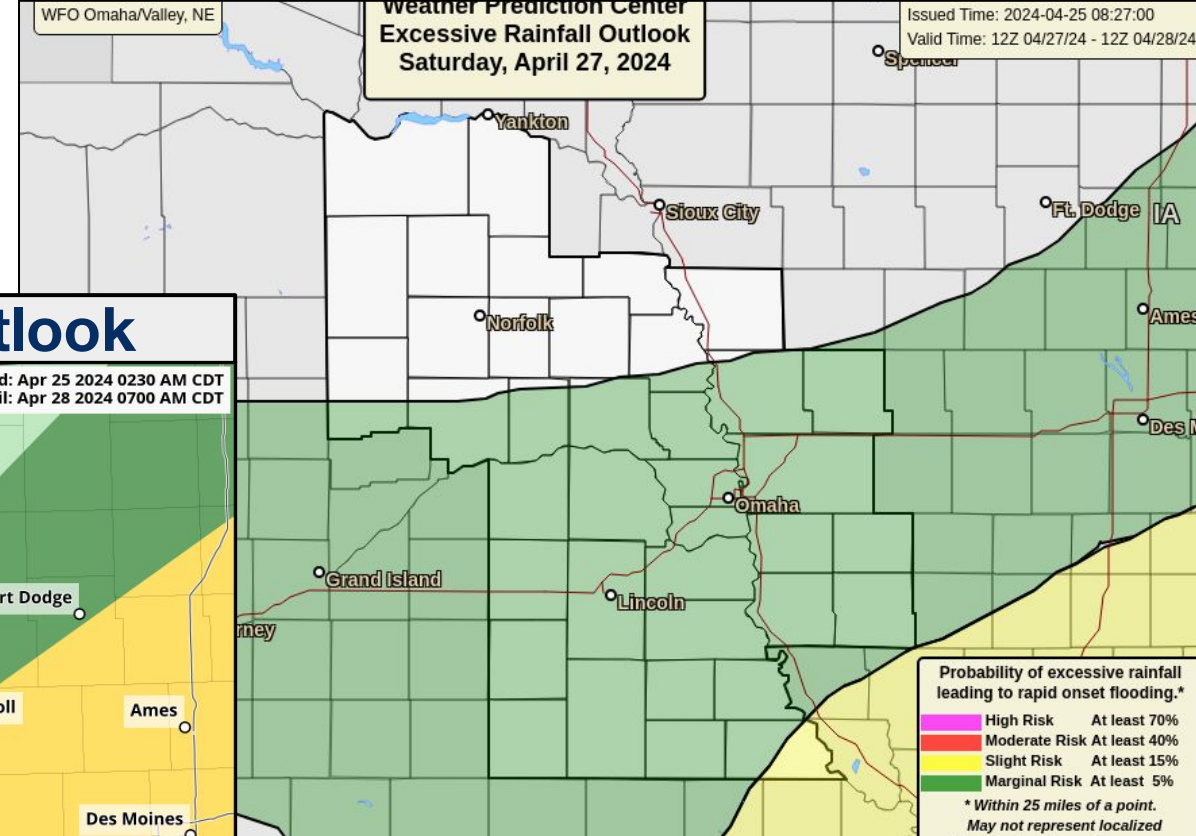

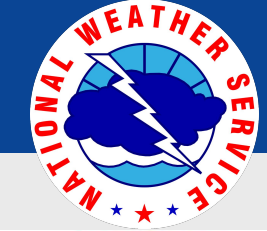

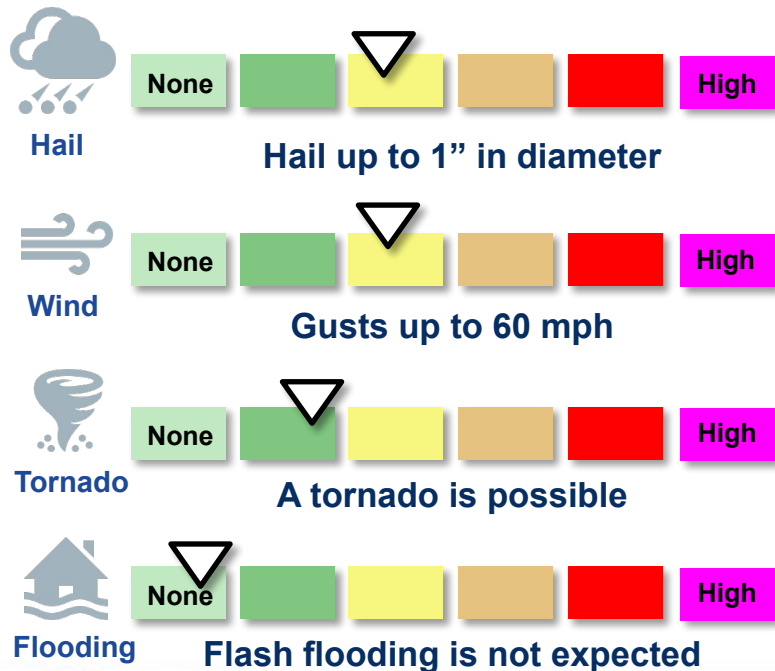
Key Points

→ A fourth round of thunderstorms could develop Sunday afternoon with the greatest severe weather threat in far southeast Nebraska and southwest Iowa. The current chance of severe weather is <30%.

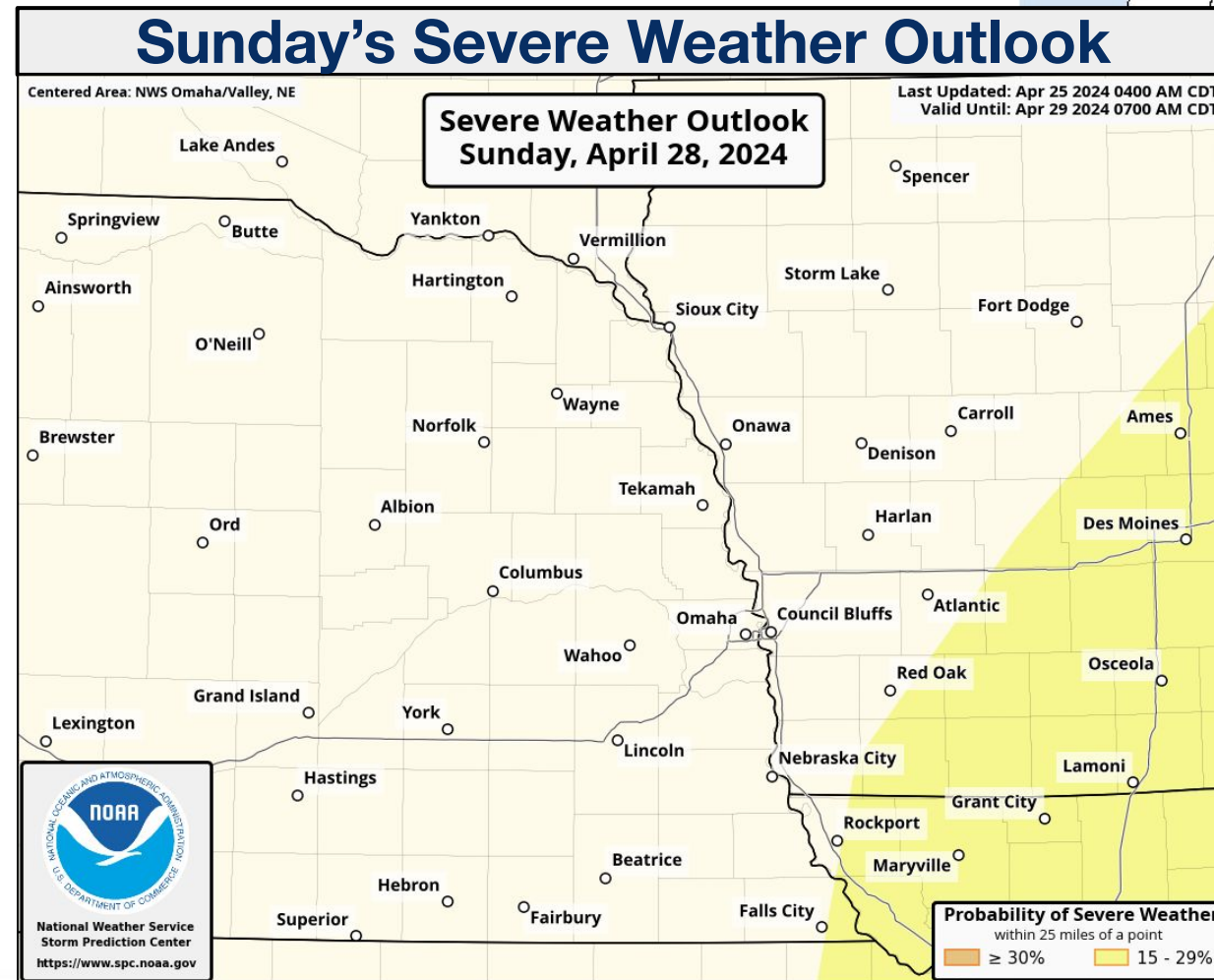
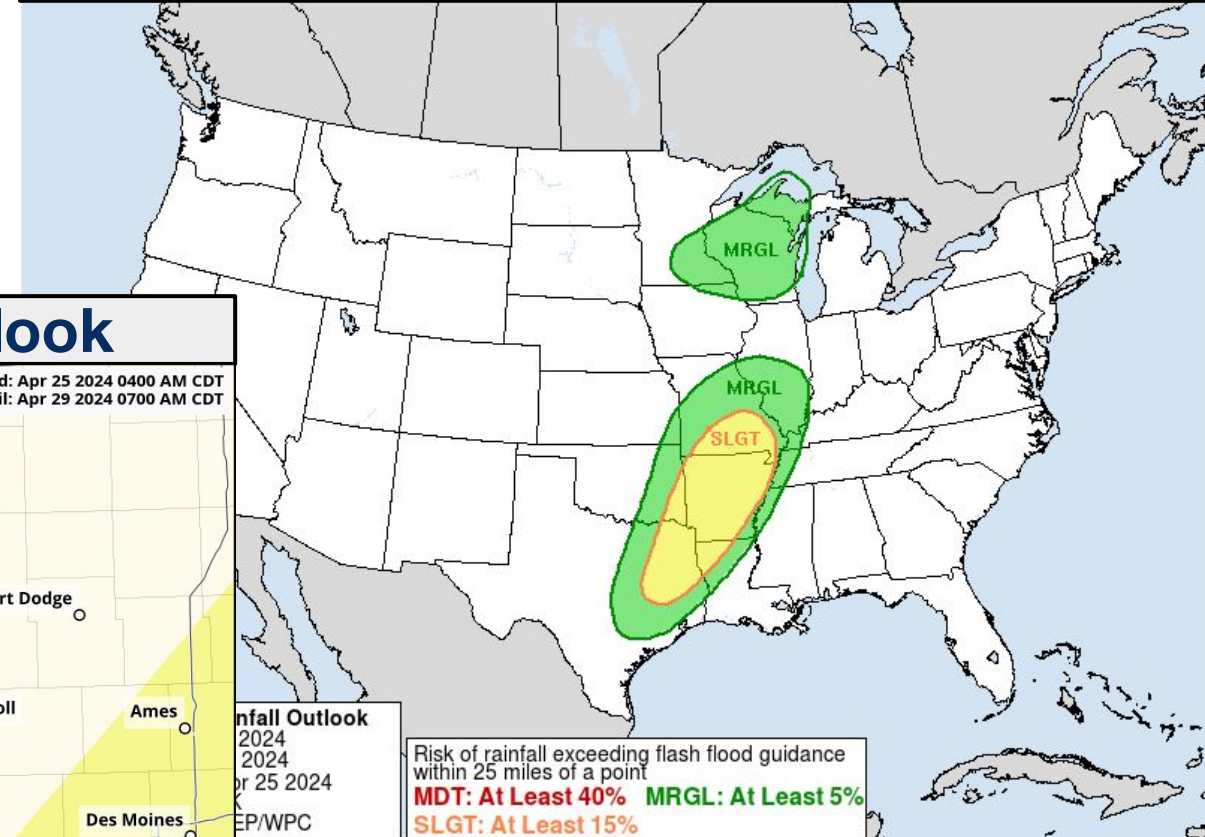
