

More Severe Weather Expected

Key Messages

- → There is an 80-100% chance of thunderstorms moving into the area from Kansas Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday night.
 - The greatest severe weather potential is near the Kansas border Wednesday evening.
- → A heavy rain and flash flood threat develops across much of the area Wednesday night into Thursday.

Important Forecast Changes

- → Thursday's severe threat continues to shift southeast.
- → Flooding remains a concern tonight through Thursday.




Storms and Heavy Rain - Late Wednesday


Key Points

- → Storms develop across northern Kansas Wednesday afternoon and spread north across the area Wednesday night.
- → The greatest severe weather threat is near the Kansas border.
- → Heavy rainfall and flash flooding is possible across much of the area late Wednesday night, after 10 pm and into Thursday morning.







Severe Weather Probabilities - Wednesday







Timing of Severe Storm Probabilities





Storms and Heavy Rain - Thursday


Key Points

- → Heavy rainfall and flash flooding is possible, primarily along and east of the Missouri River Thursday.
