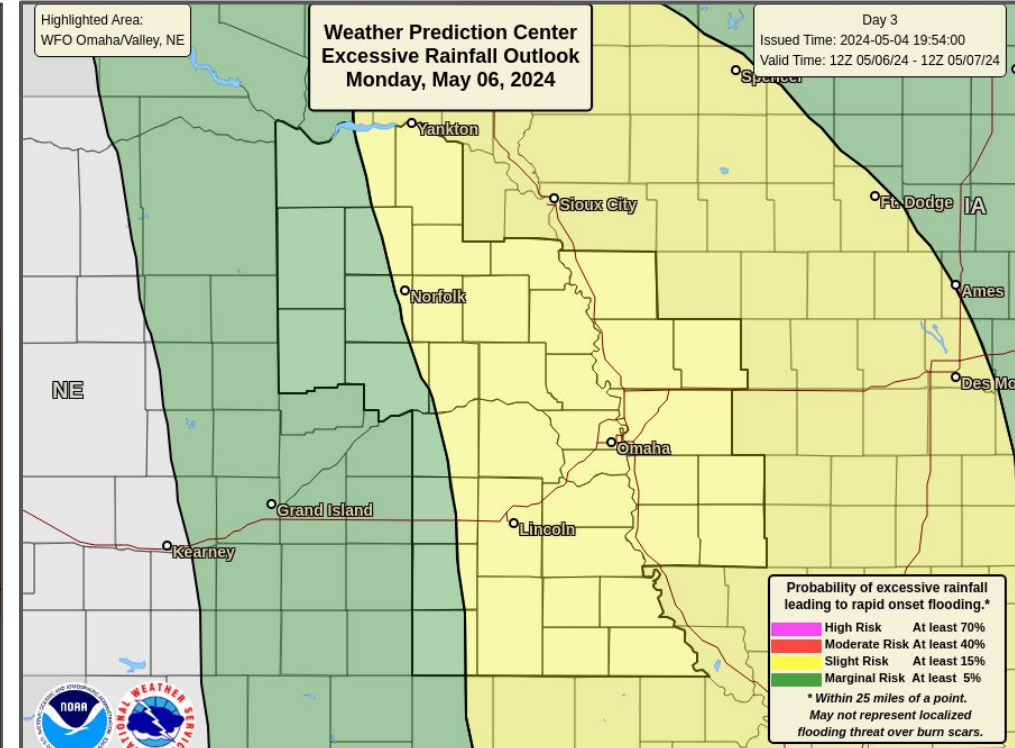
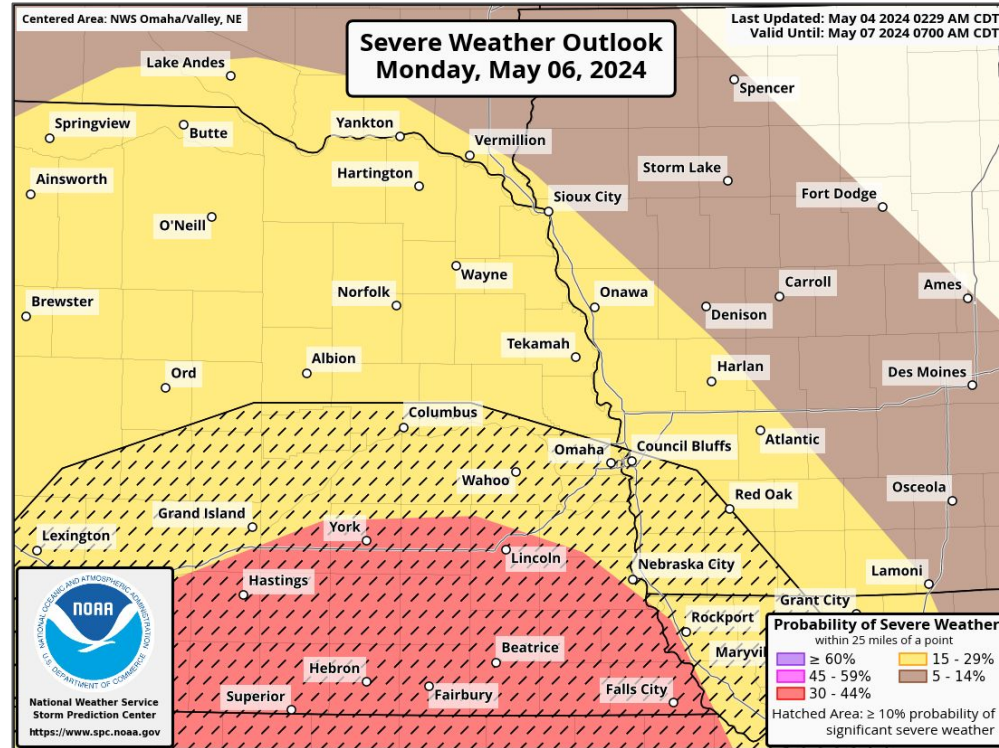
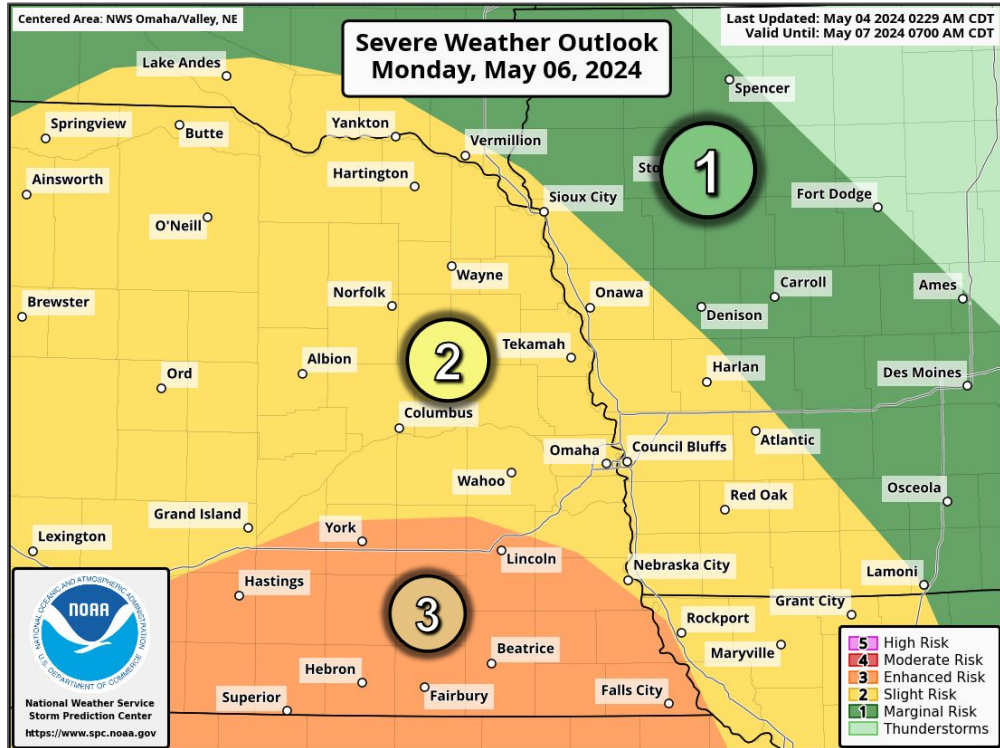

Overall Forecast Confidence



- A strong storm system is still on track to move through the region on Monday.
- Confidence remains on the higher side for the potential for severe weather on Monday afternoon and evening **4 PM through Midnight**.
- All modes of severe weather could be possible, including large hail, a few tornadoes, damaging winds, and flooding rain.
