

Severe Weather Possible Sunday & Monday

Key Messages

- → 5-15% Chance for severe storms Sunday evening
- → 15-40% Chance for severe storms Monday
- → NWS Hastings will be providing full backup for NWS Omaha warnings and operations Monday.
 - No impacts to our core services of forecast products and weather watches, warnings, and advisories are expected.
 - **♦ NOAA Weather Radio will be off air**

Overall Forecast Confidence








No Significant Change in the Forecast for Sunday Evening



What to Expect

- → There is a 40-70% chance of thunderstorms Sunday afternoon/evening; 5-20% chance of an individual storm being severe.
- → Hail, damaging winds, and a tornado or two are possible.



What to Expect

- → Severe weather is expected to redevelop by midday Monday.
- → The period's first storms may form within two counties on either side of the Missouri River.
- → Supercells will quickly grow large and powerful.
