



- Temperatures cool slightly Sunday, with lower humidities.























HeatRisk Categories






moderate




Severe Weather Possible Today & Saturday

Key Messages:


- A thunderstorm complex is expected to push across portions of northeast Nebraska both tonight and Saturday night.
- There is a 15-25% chance of storms in northeast Nebraska and a 5% chance of severe storms across the area.
- The primary hazards are damaging wind gusts (60-70 mph) and hail (up to 1").


