



Snow to Impact Travel Today

February 19, 2026
5:32 AM CST

Expect slick roads and reduced visibility

Key Messages

- Snow moves into northeast Nebraska morning and spreads east through this afternoon. Snow exits by early Friday morning.
- Northwest winds gusting 30-35 mph will lead to blowing and drifting snow and visibility under ½ mile at times.
- The Thursday morning commute may be impacted in a few spots, but expect more widespread impacts during the evening commute lasting into Friday.

Forecast Updates

- Decreased snow totals north, dropping Knox and Cedar Counties from the Winter Weather Advisory


Overall Forecast Confidence




Snowfall Forecast

February 19, 2026
5:32 AM CST

Forecast Details

- Snow rates are forecast to reach 1"/hr and result in whiteout conditions combined with the wind gusts 30 to 35 mph.
- Snow will start heavy and wet, but will become more fluffy and easier to blow/drift through the day.
- Any wet surfaces due to melting snow during the day will freeze over this evening as temperatures plunge into the 20s.




Chance of 4+ Inches of Snow

Key Messages

- Areas along a line from Columbus to Omaha to Atlantic have a 65 to 85% chance of 4+ inches of snow.
- ◆ A sharp 1 to 2 county cut-off in snow amounts is expected to the north and south of these areas.




Winter Weather Timing

February 19, 2026
5:32 AM CST

Timing Details

- Light snow begins later this morning between 6-9am in northeast Nebraska spreading east by this afternoon.
- Minor impacts for the morning commute in a few spots due to the combination of light snow and gusty winds.
- More widespread travel impacts are expected for the evening commute with blowing and drifting snow possible.
- The heaviest snow is expected between 3PM - 9PM.
- Light snow lingers into the evening and tapers off overnight.

Winds Pick Up Thursday

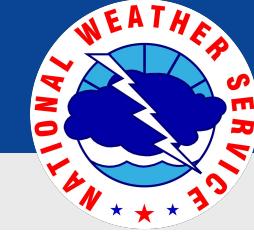
Winds gust as high as 35 mph

Key Messages

- Northeast winds increase during the morning. Wind gusts of 30 to 35 mph are forecast.
- Winds shift to the north-northwest in the afternoon.
- The combination of gusty winds and falling snow/new snowfall will result in blowing and drifting snow.
- Blowing snow will cause reductions to visibility and result in travel impacts during the evening commute.
- Wind chills in the single digits are expected Thursday night into Friday morning.
