Dear Custodian of Records of Glasgow City Government:

I write this letter requesting access to records of the Glasgow Police Department.

Pursuant to the state open records law Ky. Rev. Stat. Ann. Secs. 61.870 to 61.884 and 61.991, I write to request access to and a copy of any and all records pertaining to the death of Jeremy S. Marr, who died in police custody on April 14, 2020. Records I request specifically include body camera footage from each officer involved in the altercation; 911 CAD report in connection the dispatch of Glasgow Police, and any other emergency personnel, to the Cleveland Avenue home of Evic Tharpe; dispatch records pertaining to the said incident; witness interviews; medical examiner's records indicating Marr's cause of death; and complete personnel files for Cameron Murrell, Guy Turcotte, Hayden Phillips, Mark Cromwell and Justin Claywell.

If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address.

I agree to pay any reasonable copying and postage fees of not more than \$.10 per page. If the cost would be greater than this amount, please notify me. Please provide a receipt indicating the charges for each document.


As provided by the open records law, I will expect your response within three (3) business days. See Ky. Rev. Stat. Ann. Sec. 61.880(1).

If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for each denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material.

I would note that willful violation of the open records law is a Class A misdemeanor and can result in a fine of up to \$25 for each day that I am denied access, as well as the award of attorney fees and costs. See Ky. Rev. Stat. Ann. Secs. 61.882(5) and 61.991(2).
