Due to the excessive dryness and fire hazard conditions and at the request of the local Volunteer Fire Departments, Judge/Executive Micheal Hale has signed an Executive Order declaring a ban on open burning in Barren County, effective immediately.

No person shall light or maintain an open fire at any location in Barren County while this ban is in effect, with the exception of camp fires in an established campground.

Any person violating this ban shall be subject to fines and penalties.

This ban shall remain in effect until further notice.
