



Thank you for supporting the 2023 Adopt-A-Family program. Your generosity will make a difference to a Saskatoon family this holiday season.

Staying within these guidelines helps ensure Christmas hampers are equitable and sustainable. If you have a larger budget, we encourage you to adopt multiple families. We thank you for your cooperation.

What should I provide?

When adopting a family, you should **provide a food hamper** for the family **and toys for children under 14 years** of age. **Gifts must be new**, in their store-bought packaging, age appropriate **and unwrapped** so parents can see what they are giving their child.

Each child should receive **one main gift between \$20 and \$40**, and **one smaller gift in the range of \$10**.

What should the food hamper contain?

We live in a diverse community with families of varying cultures and ethnicities. Many sponsors choose to **provide a grocery gift card**, which allows the family to purchase food items they commonly enjoy. You may also choose to **pack your own food hamper**.

Food Hamper Cost Guide: Small Family (2-3) = \$75 Medium Family (4-5) = \$100 Large Family (6 or more) = \$125

Suggested Food Hamper Contents

Grocery Gift Card	Potatoes	Pasta	Canned Fruit	Pancake Mix
Canned Beans/ Meat	Carrots	Pasta Sauce	Oranges/Apples	Maple Syrup
Boxed Stuffing	Canned Veggies	Rice	Juice	Dessert
Gravy (mix or can)	Cranberry Sauce	Canned Soup	Jam and Bread	Cookies

Foods requiring refrigeration and/or freezing, alcohol and tobacco products are not allowed

Where do I drop off my hamper?

You will be provided with a drop off date and time when you are matched with a family. Your drop off date will be **on either December 11 or 13 between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** Dates and times are scheduled in the order registrations are received.

Gifts are to be **dropped off at The Salvation Army (38 Bateman Crescent)** at your scheduled time.
