**TO: THE MEMBERS OF THE LAW SOCIETY OF SASKATCHEWAN**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT Dwayne Stonechild** of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan has been placed on interim suspension pursuant to section 45 of *The Legal Profession Act, 1990* and Law Society of Saskatchewan Rule 1121, and is not entitled to practice law until further notice.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan has reasonable grounds to believe that Dwayne Stonechild has repeatedly failed to comply with court ordered processes set out by the Federal Court of Canada in connection with the payment of his fees pursuant to the Federal Indian Day School litigation process and has taken fees without Court authorization and without Court approval as is required by the process.

The Law Society of Saskatchewan Conduct Investigation Committee has determined that, while formal allegations in relation to the above have yet to be advanced or proven, further investigation is required in connection with the conduct of Dwayne Stonechild and that to allow him to continue to practice during the investigation would present an immediate risk to the public.
